Notification: In accordance with the Alcohol and/or other Drug Program Certification Standards, Section 12(a), the program shall submit the Request for License and/or Certification Extension DHCS Form 6043 with all supporting documentation and renewal fees to the department, via LCDQuestions@dhcs.ca.gov **90 days** prior to the expiration date of the certificate. Failure to provide all necessary documentation shall result in the termination of the certificate in accordance with Section 17(d).
